# What is **IELTS?**

IELTS is an English test that assesses your listening, reading, writing and speaking skills.

It helps you develop the kind of English you need in everyday life, whether you are at college, at work or talking to friends.

There are two test types:

**IELTS Academic** is for higher education or professional training.

**IELTS General Training** is for secondary education, migration, work or training.



Whichever test you take, you'll get a score from 1 to 9 for each section -Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking.

For visa applications, the UK Home Office has approved IELTS, IELTS for UKVI and IELTS Life Skills.


#### Applying for Student Route Visa (Tier 4)?

If you are applying to a university that is a Tier 4 Sponsor to study for a bachelor or postgraduate degree, you must meet the English language level set by that institution. Almost all British universities and colleges accept IELTS results.

# About IELTS for UKVI and IELTS Life Skills

#### **IELTS for UKVI**

IELTS for UKVI is a government-approved English language test that can be used in support of a UK Visa and Immigration application.

#### **IELTS Life Skills**

IELTS Life Skills is used for specific types of applications – a 'family of a settled person' visa, an 'indefinite leave to remain' visa and for citizenship.

It is a test of Speaking and Listening available at CEFR Levels A1, A2 and B1.

#### The purpose of each test

**IELTS Life Skills A1** For those applying to UK Visas and Immigration for a 'family of a settled person' visa.

#### IELTS Life Skills A2

For those applying to UK Visas and Immigration for an extension to a family, spouse or partner visa.

#### IELTS Life Skills B1

For those applying to UK Visas and Immigration for indefinite leave to remain or citizenship.

If you are emigrating to another country, contact its immigration authority to find out which IELTS test and score you need.

# Your test, your way

You can choose to take your IELTS test in a test centre, or online.


#### **IELTS in a test centre**

Our test centres offer both IELTS on computer or IELTS on paper options for your Academic or General Training test. The only difference is for the Listening, Reading and Writing sections, you can either type or write your answers. The choice is yours.

#### **IELTS Online**

IELTS Online has the same test content as IELTS on computer and IELTS on paper taken in a test centre, but you can take it from the comfort of your own home or private space.

The Speaking test is the same for both tests and is done face-to-face with a qualified IELTS Examiner. IELTS Online is carried out via a video call.



#### More choice, same trusted test

Whether you choose to take your test in a test centre or at home, the test content and scoring system is the same. All test formats also have the same Report Form and security measures that make IELTS the world's most trusted English language test.

## Your test results

#### When do I receive my test score?

- Between 3–5 days of taking IELTS on computer
- Within 13 days of taking IELTS on paper
- Within 3–6 days of taking IELTS Online (you will receive an email telling you your results are available and how to access
- Within 7 days of taking IELTS Life Skills

Send your results to up to five (IELTS on computer and IELTS on paper) or an unlimited number of universities (IELTS Online) for free Visit takeielts.britishcouncil.org/teach-ielts/ test-information/results for more details.

#### Can I apply for a re-mark?

If you are unhappy with your test results, you can apply for your test to be remarked. This is called an Enquiry on Results. You have up to six weeks after the test to make the request and can choose which section of the test you would like to be marked again.

The re-mark fee will be refunded if your score is increased. Contact your test centre to apply.
